Republican Happenings in Portage!

HERE'S WHAT THE PORTAGE REPUBLICAN TEAM HAS BEEN UP TO:

The Portage Republicans held a food drive on March 27th and at the end of the event which was held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. we were able to collect 523 pounds of food for the Portage Township food pantry and we were able to collect monetary donations as well. A total of \$700 was received in donations!

Joseph Kasper is the president of the Portage Township food pantry. He also was there at the event and gave us all a tour of the facilities. Much of their equipment like refrigerators and freezers are obtained through federal grants, but much of their operating cost are from community and public donations — especially the food. They also purchase items in bulk and many local stores give large donations of their surplus to the food pantry to help meet their inventory needs.



Some helpful information about the food pantry itself is that it supports on average roughly 200 families per month and about 50% of the recipients are single senior citizens. The food pantry is available every week on Thursdays and eligibility requirements must be met through the Portage Township trustee's office. In addition, for families to qualify their threshold income as a family and meet the income standards set by the Portage Pantry. Generally, this means family income which must not exceed 200% of the poverty guideline.

Shannon McNeish led the team of our Portage Republican planners which included Melissa Wiedenbach, Robin Crawford, Victoria Gresham and Jena-Rae and Manny Maldonado.

Study: Biden Administration Has Successfully Reduced Media Coverage Of Border Crisis By 867%

U.S.—A new study has found that Biden has successfully handled the border crisis by reducing the amount of media coverage of the border crisis by 867%.

Controversial Georgia Law Requires Poll Workers To Check Voters For A Pulse

ATLANTA, GA—Republican Governor Brian Kemp has signed into law sweeping overhauls to Georgia’s election law, including a provision requiring poll workers to check for a pulse before allowing voters to cast a ballot.

Voting rights advocates decried the controversial bill crafted by the Peach State’s Republicans as an act intended to suppress turnout of the state’s many dead Democratic voters, thereby ensuring Republican victories for local, state, and federal races.

“This is just unconscionable and based entirely on lies from the Trump 2020 campaign that somehow voters with a pulse are more valid,” read a joint statement from Georgia-based corporations. “No-pulse voters have always had a say in how their state is run and we think that shouldn’t be changed just to help Republicans win every time. We are considering a boycott until this injustice is corrected.”

“This is discrimination of the highest order,” declared Stacey Abrams from the Office of Rightful Governor Of Georgia. “This is disenfranchisement. It’s Jim Crow 2.0. A heartbeat has never been the definition of a registered voter. This bill is voter suppression. We need to count every vote. It’s just that plain and simple.”

Governor Kemp defended the bill when peppered with questions by the national corporate press that suddenly cared about Georgia by stating, “What? They’re dead. Dead people don’t get a vote!”

At publishing time, voting rights advocates released another statement reminding the nation that democracy dies in darkness.
